The school emphasizes faith, morals and service to the community. Through its work study program, the school fosters skills and attitudes important in the workplace, such as responsibility, determination, and respect for self and others. In the finest tradition of Catholic outreach, we welcome families of all denominations. With a challenging and supportive college-preparatory program, we equip students with the core knowledge and competencies needed for college and the workplace. Our ultimate goal is to enable students to gain the skills to be successful in life and commit to making a difference in their families, neighborhoods, and the workd.

#### HISTORY

Detroit Cristo Rey opened its doors in August 2008. Since then, DCRHS has maintained a commitment to one-on-one attention in the classroom by serving no more than 350 students across four grade levels. Detroit Cristo Rey is a Catholic school sponsored by the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, and the Congregation of Saint Basil.

### **CORPORATE WORK STUDY PROGRAM**

The Corporate Work Study Program (CWSP) is an integral part of the student's educational experience at Detroit Cristo Rey. It not only allows them to earn up to half of their own tuition, but it provides unique learning opportunities for our students five days a month. Detroit Cristo Rey partners with more than 50 local organizations including law firms, hospitals, banks, nonprofits, and other businesses. The CWSP provides students the opportunity to gain valuable workplace experience, exposure to potential career paths, and helps them develop the confidence and professional skillsets that will give them a competitive advantage in college and their careers.



## **Our Students Give Back:**

As a faith-based institution, Detroit Cristo Rey requires all students to complete 10 hours of community service each year in a role of their choice. Seniors must have a total of 40 verified service hours to graduate.
