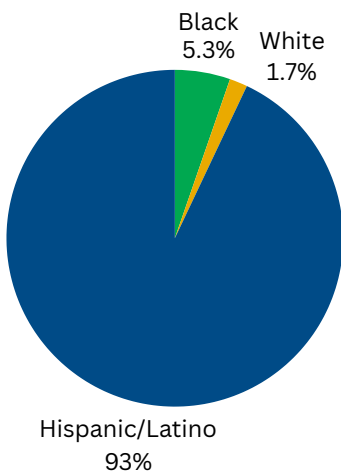
HISTORY

Detroit Cristo Rey opened its doors in August 2008. Since then, DCRHS has maintained a commitment to one-on-one attention in the classroom by serving no more than 350 students across four grade levels. Detroit Cristo Rey is a Catholic school sponsored by the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, and the Congregation of Saint Basil.

CORPORATE WORK STUDY PROGRAM

The Corporate Work Study Program (CWSP) is an integral part of the student’s educational experience at Detroit Cristo Rey. It not only allows them to earn up to half of their own tuition, but it provides unique learning opportunities for our students five days a month. Detroit Cristo Rey partners with more than 50 local organizations including law firms, hospitals, banks, nonprofits, and other businesses. The CWSP provides students the opportunity to gain valuable workplace experience, exposure to potential career paths, and helps them develop the confidence and professional skillsets that will give them a competitive advantage in college and their careers.

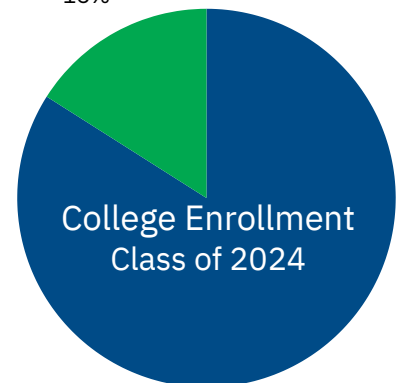
